

INDIA-UK STARTUP HUB

An MoU was signed between The Government of The United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland through The Department Of International Development (DFID) and Department Of External Affairs to set-up UK India Fast Track Startup fund of £38 million for investments into tech startups. This fund is set to launch in the H2′ 20.

A delegation of Indian Startups participated at TechXchange, 2019. This delegation was accompanied by officials from DPIIT and Startup India team.

In September 2019, a roundtable was organized between Fintech startups from India and UK at Invest India which was graced by **Lord Mayor of London.** This roundtable facilitated exchange of best practices and market insights between the entrepreneur



INDIA-KOREA STARTUP HUB



LAUNCHED BY THE PRIME MINISTER OF INDIA, SHRI. NARENDRA MODI IN FEBURARY 2019



The online bridge was conceptualized as part of the joint statement signed between Korea Trade-Investment Promotion Agency (KOTRA) and Invest India on 9th July 2018. To enable cross pollination and collaboration, two corporate challenges were launched by Startup India in collaboration with State Bank of India (SBI) & Mahindra Group to offer cash grants worth USD 60K to Indian and Korean startups under this Startup Hub.

Also, Korea Startup Centre was launched in September 2019 by Ministry of SMES and Startups (Korea) in India. This centre assists Korean startups to expand to India by providing co-working space and also enables co-creation between Indian and Korean startups.

JAPAN-INDIA STARTUP HUB



LAUNCHED IN OCTOBER 2018 BY THE PRIME MINISTER OF INDIA, SHRI. NARENDRA MODI



Invest India and SoftBank Group partnered to launch **Tech4Future**, an innovation challenge to identify and support startups, under this Startup Hub, in the fields of artificial intelligence, machine learning, face recognition, and cyber security for a cash grant of USD 50,000 and potential incubation opportunity.

Startup India hosted a delegation of over 15 top Japanese Venture Capital firms at the Startup India Venture Capital Summit 2018. This event was focused on mobilising Global Capital for Indian Startups.

Invest India partnered with JETRO for Japan as a Business partner event to help Indian startups explore Japan as a potential business destination and further expand.

An MoU was signed between Invest India, Netherlands Embassy in India and State Secretary of Economic Affairs & Climate Policy and the Indo-Dutch Startup Link was launched.

Startup India collaborated for The Next Web with the Embassy of Netherlands in May 2019, along with a delegation of Indian Startups for Market Access and expansion opportunity.

Also co-organized the GITR NL India Startup Nexus as part of India-Netherlands
Technology Summit in October 2019. The selected 15 Indian and 15 Dutch Startups got an opportunity to pitch their solution in front of an eminent jury for the winning prize.

ASEAN-India Grand Challenge was

launched as a part of the bridge to identify solutions for sectors such as Digital Health & Clean India. Five Indian State Governments came together to support the Challenge on an international platform by co-collaborating with the startups. The Challenge was open to nationals of all ASEAN Countries including Singapore.

Also, Inspreneur program was ideated and launched by Startup India and High Commission of India in Singapore. DPIIT and Invest India participated in Inspreneur 2019 along with key Indian experts.

INDIA-ISRAEL INNOVATION BRIDGE

The India—Israel Innovation Bridge is a joint initiative between the Israel Innovation Authority and DPIIT, Ministry of Commerce & Industry.

As part of **Co-Creation Summit** organized in India and Israel, applications were invited to solve problems in the fields of Water, Agriculture and Health from Indian and Israeli

startups. The selected startups participated in a 5-day long market access program. It also provided free incubation opportunity for startups, cash grants and free working space for the startups.

INDO-RUSSIA INNOVATION BRIDGE



LAUNCHED BY THE PRIME MINISTER OF INDIA, SHRI NARENDRA MODI DURING THE EASTERN ECONOMIC FORUM IN SEPTEMBER 2019



An MoU was signed between **Invest India** and **Skolkovo Foundation** in September 2019 to build a collaborative innovation and R&D ecosystem between the two nations.

As part of the innovation bridge, **Kalyani EdTech Challenge** was launched that invited solutions from innovators in India and Russia in the EdTech space. The Innovation

challenge received over 271 applications.
Startup India also launched a corporate program with MTS Startup Hub to provide a market access and acceleration opportunity to Indian startups in Skolkova.

INDIA-PORTUGAL STARTUP HUB



LAUNCHED BY PRIME MINISTER OF PORTUGAL, H.E. ANTONIA COSTA AND PRIME MINISTER OF INDIA, SHRI. NARENDA MODI IN JUNE 2017



An MoU was signed between Invest India and Startup Portugal in 2017 with the goal to strengthen the relationships between the two startup ecosystems.

Under the MoU, **Startup Visa' program** was launched- a visa facilitation program to help Indian entrepreneurs who want

to launch and expand their business in Portugal. Startup Visa is a **residence visa for non-EU-Schenghen startup founders.**

The MoU was renewed in February 2020 to expand the scope of collaboration.
